This conference which is going to be the 10th consecutive Annual Conference will be attended by 650 participants from YPFDJ chapters around the world.

The conference aims to involve Eritrean youth activists who are serving their communities and nation in different capacities. Also, several community leaders and organisation representatives will be participating in the conference which will be addressing pertinent topics that affects the Eritrean youth inside and outside the country.
