WHEREAS, the Eritrean-American Community will celebrate the 24th Anniversary of the Independence of the State of Eritrea on May 24, 2015; and


WHEREAS, in a city full of different cultures and origins, the presence of the Eritrean community signifies a lot more than local residents, it is the diversity our city prides itself in; and


WHEREAS: members of the City Council recognize the Eritrean community in Garland and congratulate them on their 24th Independence Day on May 24, 2015.
